FINGERPLAY: TEN LITTLE CLOWNS

Say This:

Ten little clowns, standing in a row.

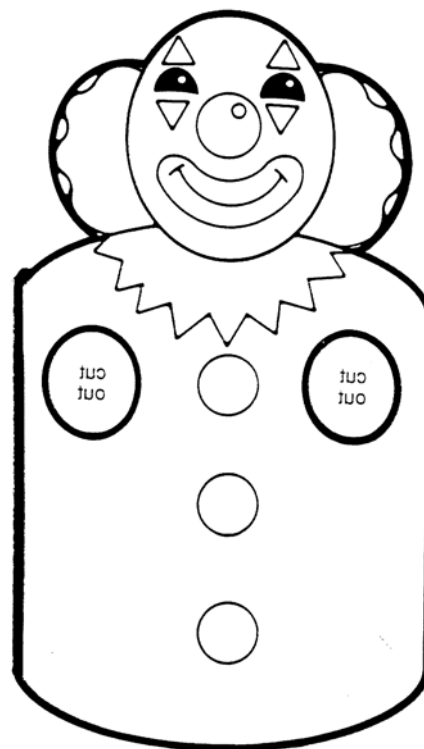
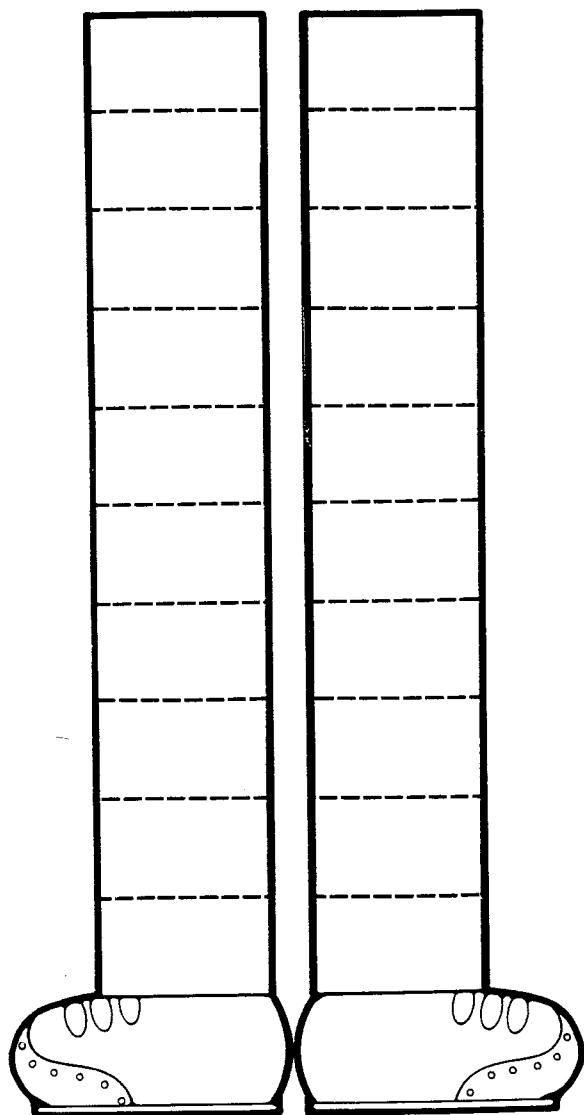
