### **FINGERPLAY: FIVE LITTLE DUCKS**

#### **Say This:**

Five ducks and five ducks  
That makes ten.  
They waddle to the gate,

#### **Do This:**

*Hold up one hand, then other,  
fingers outstretched.

"Waddle" hands to center.*

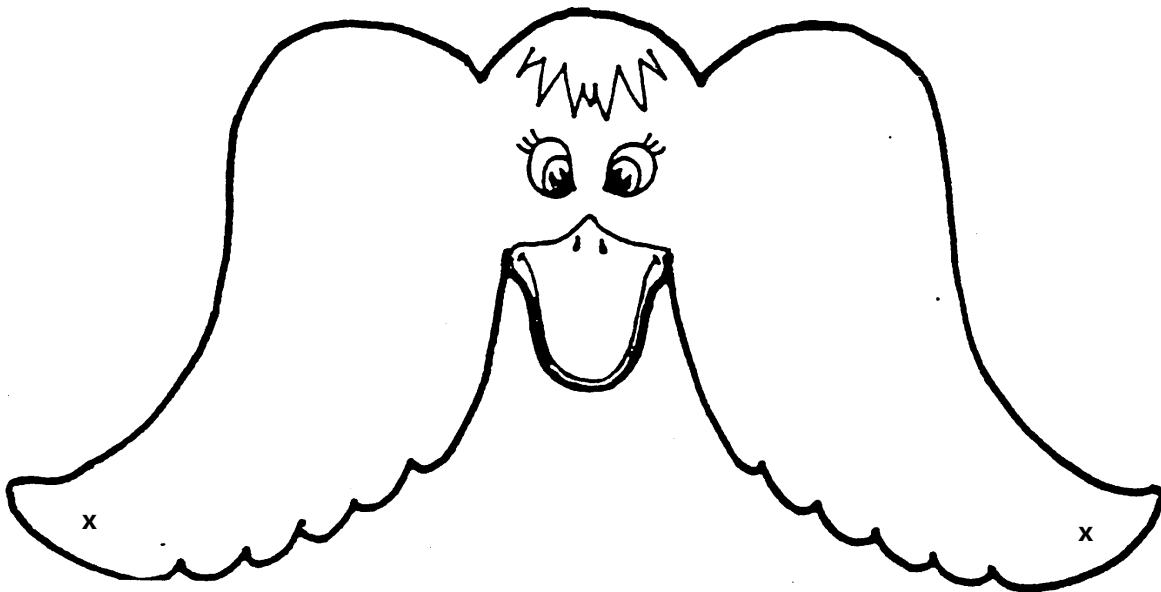

### CRAFT: DUCK HAT

#### Instructions:

1. Cut out patterns for body and wing.
2. Color duck
3. Fold wing on line, and glue to duck's body.
4. Staple to 2" headband (cut from extra paper).
